It is an innovative first-responder model of police-based crisis intervention training to help persons with mental disorders and/or addictions access medical treatment rather than place them in the criminal justice system due to illness-related behaviors.

Once the anxiety level has been reduced by supportive counseling, the worker can engage the client in reflective discussion, which involves focusing on the nature of the objective reality of the situation and helping the client devise approaches for dealing with the crisis situation.
