The essential elements you require to create a journal article reference include: Author or authors including surname and initial. [Call out: include the second initial if available]; Year of

publication, Title of article.

How to Cite an Online Journal or Newspaper Article in Harvard Format. To cite an online journal or newspaper article, the page numbers section from the print journal or newspaper reference is swapped with the URL or DOI the article can be accessed from and when it was accessed. So the reference for an online journal article is: Author surname(s), initial(s). (Year) 'Title of article', Title of journal, volume(issue/season) [online]. Available at: URL or DOI (Accessed: day month year)

Bing: Harvard Reference Journal Article

In Harvard style, to reference a journal article, you need the author name (s), the year, the article title, the journal name, the volume and issue numbers, and the page range on which the article appears. If you accessed the article online, add a DOI (digital object identifier) if available. Author surname, initial.

Harvard Reference List Citations for Journal Articles Found on a Database or on a Website When citing journal articles found on a database or through a website, include all of the components found in a citation of a print journal, but also include the medium ([online]), the website URL, and the date that the article was accessed.

‘Harvard referencing’ is an umbrella term for any referencing style that uses the author name and year of publication within the text to indicate where you have inserted a source. This author-date system appeals to both authors and readers of academic work. Scholars find the format an economical way of writing, and it is generally more accessible to the reader as there are no footnotes crowding the page.

Harvard Referencing – How to Cite a Journal Article. ‘Harvard referencing’ (so-called for having originated at Harvard University) refers to citing sources in brackets. It’s also one of the most widely-used citation systems in academic writing, especially in the humanities. Many variations of the basic Harvard ‘author-date’ system exist, making it important to check your style guide for specifics.

Include the full title of the journal in your reference. Abbreviated titles are not used in the Leeds Harvard style. Use p. to reference a single page, and pp. for a range of pages. If you are referencing a journal article which you have read online (on a website or as a PDF), you do not need to include [online], the URL or the access date in your reference.

The Harvard Referencing System is one of the preferred layouts for these references. It is a relatively strict way of arranging the bibliographical information. This tool takes in the raw information - author, title, year of publication - and creates the reference in the correct form.

For in-text references, only list the name of the first author followed by et al (meaning 'and others'). Cite the names of the authors in the order they appear. For the reference list, list all authors - do not use et al. For the reference list, enter the authors in the order they appear on the title page of the article
