History & Culture - Saugus Iron Works National Historic ...

The Saugus River was the key to the operation of the iron works here. Water was needed to run the wheels that powered the machinery in each building. The river was dammed upstream in the 1640s to create a large reservoir. A canal brought water from the reservoir to a holding pond that existed on the higher ground behind the forge building.

The land that makes up Saugus Iron Works National Historic Site has been used by many different people over time. Archaeological evidence shows that Native American groups used the land here for thousands of years. The Native Americans who were in the area at the time of contact with Europeans are known as the Pawtucket.

The mill harnessed the water power of the Saugus River to fuel the furnace. The Europeans had to improvise, too. Lacking limestone for flux, the colonists mined gabbro instead to purify the ore. The 9-acre National Park is best seen with a tour guide who can explain the equipment and cool old tools, including a 500-pound hammer.
